# Invitation to NJS Seminar

## The German Rail Connection to the Fehmarn Belt

NJS – Forum of Nordic Railway Professionals is proudly inviting you to a webinar about the German rail connection to the Fehmarn Belt link. In September 2008, Denmark and Germany signed a state treaty to plan and build a fixed link under the Fehmarn Belt. Denmark is building an immersed tunnel between Lolland and Fehmarn as well as the necessary connections on the Danish side for road and rail traffic. Germany has promised to build road and rail links on the German side. Today's track between Puttgarden and Lübeck is an 80 km non-electrified, single-track line with a maximum speed of 140 km/h. How will the German rail connection be designed and will the time schedule hold? Ulrike Schenka-van Capelleveen, Head of Stakeholder Management of the project at Deutsche Bahn will give a detailed presentation of the German plans.
